

PVYSC Neenah Wizards – Red/White

Goal

The goal of the Neenah Wizards Red is to continue to play at the State League level in the Fall and Spring seasons in order to challenge and develop quality players. If there are enough players to form a Neenah Wizards White team, they will play in the East Central league.

Coaching

The projected head coach for the Neenah Wizards is Jim Schmidt. Coach Schmidt holds a State D license and has coached with the club for several years, both in the classic and recreational programs.

Training

The Wizards will train one to two days a week during the Fall, and at least one day a week during the winter before resuming two-a-day practices in the Spring. The team will work with a trainer in its fall and spring sessions.

Tournaments

The Wizards usually play one fall tournament, one winter/spring tournament and three to four summer tournaments. At least one of those summer tournaments will require out-of-town travel. In the past, the Wizards have played tournaments in Milwaukee, Oregon and Rockford that require an overnight stay.

Indoor Soccer

The Wizards Red team will play at least two sessions at Soccer Heaven, U14 plays on Saturday mornings. The Wizards White team will play at least two sessions at Soccer Heaven, U13 plays on Friday evenings. We will take several weeks off in the winter to give players, parents and coaches a break.

Playing Time

Playing time on the Wizards is determined by a simple formula: Attendance, Attitude and Accomplishment. During the indoor season, playing time is split more evenly as we try to develop players. During the Fall and Spring season, equal playing time is not guaranteed.

Budget

Classic soccer on any level is both a commitment in time and money. In the past two seasons, the Wizards have been able to play and train year-round for about \$600 to \$700 for the season.

Principles of Play

We have three guiding principles for play on the Wizards:

- To have fun.
- To improve as players.
- To play again next season.
