Team Philosophy: “Playing time is earned, not given”. Everyone on the team is expected to put the best interest of the team first, before any thought is given to individual accomplishments. No individual, coach or player, is more important than the team. Soccer should also be FUN. We will strive to make practices and games enjoyable experiences that will both develop skills and provide positive life long memories for every player.

Team Goals: Our goal is to become a State League Team

Practice: Players are expected to attend ALL practices, although we understand that conflicts occasionally arise. Missed practice(s) will have an impact on playing time. If your child is involved in several activities and it proves difficult to make practices, you may want to reconsider making the commitment to this team. Every player is expected to attend and work hard at every practice.

Playing Time: What specifically does “Playing time is earned, not given” mean? The amount of playing time each player receives will depend on his/her attitude, skill level, commitment to the team, absences, injuries and game/tournament situations. Players who are physically, technically, and tactically stronger at their positions will see a little more playing time: performance based on playing time.

Schedule:

Indoor Soccer - Based on Teams interest, we will have an active indoor season; possible indoor Tournament.

Fall League – The team will play one or two Fall tournaments

Summer League – The team will play in the Top U12 league; our goal is to become a State League Team! We should play at least four tournaments: the two Neenah tournaments and two team choices.

Expenses: The cost, depending on the number of tournaments we enter, will most likely be around \$400+; not including travel expenses. For new players needing uniforms, there would be an added expense for the uniform: roughly \$125-\$150 (uniforms are generally worn for two or more seasons).

Team Offers: After the evaluation and alternate evaluation sessions are complete, the assessors’ data will be used to rate the players. After the tryouts are over, calls will be made to offer spots on the Gunners Team. Families are asked to respond ASAP.
