

## 2009/2010 PVYSC U12 Girls National team

**Head Coach** Jerry Crossman, currently holds a D license and has coached and played soccer for 20+ years. Previously coached PVYSC Lasers who have played National, First division and Premier League. Assistant coaches will be selected once the team has been chosen with guidance from PVYSC.

**Financial** Will need uniforms at approximately \$150, for new additions to team. Club fee is \$100 per player and then the rest will be based on the number of fall tournaments. Costs will be determined later, for indoor and trainer sessions as well as next summer...

**Commitment/practices** Attendance is critical to the development of the player and the team. Team practices will be twice a week for the fall (days and times to be determined, one of those sessions will be with a trainer). Everyone is expected to attend unless previously excused. The same plan will be for Spring with a practice and a trainer...

Fall Tournaments We will play two tournaments in the fall.  
We will also apply for U12 State league in the Fall..

**Philosophy** The two main goals of the team are to have fun and to develop each player's skills as an individual and as a team player. It is understood that soccer is not the only thing these girls have going on. We will try to coordinate practices to best fit everyone's schedule and will work with everyone to make things work. These girls will be a select group, so we will practice hard and play hard to be as competitive as we can. Good sportsmanship will also be encouraged as that is just as important in player development.

**Participation** Playing time will depend on the competition of the team we are playing against along with the girls ability to play at that level. Every girl will play in every game, but playing half of every game is not a guarantee.

**This year we would like to have one person that will play goalie at least for one half of all the games, so note that on your sheet if willing.**

### **Expectations**

Coaches	Keep it fun but really challenge the girls to develop individual and teams skills.
Players	Work hard, be committed, have a positive attitude and have fun.
Parents	Be positive fans and good sports on the sidelines
