Crossfire White Mission:

Training:

The Crossfire White will train 2 days per week in the fall and the spring and 1 day per week in the winter. Additional practices may be held in August before school starts. The team will work with a trainer in the fall and spring. Every player is expected to attend and work hard at every practice.

League Play:
