TEAM MANAGEMENT

TEAM GOALS

League: The team will apply to play in the National League based on its record in the American league for the 2009 season (currently undefeated in league play).

Tournaments: The team will look to compete at tournaments which promote improvement.

The team will plan to carry 15-16 roster spots. The goals for the team players are:

1. Develop individual and team skills
2. Develop individual and team competitive skills
3. Develop love for the game
4. Develop sportsmanship and respect for the game, opponents and referees
5. Give best opportunity to earn roster spots in next levels

TRAINING SCHEDULE

FALL: Practice will begin in mid-August; practices will be 3 times per week, except on weeks with league games or tournaments.

WINTER: Indoor practices, 1 time per week (plan on playing at least 2 sessions of indoor)

SPRING: 3 times per week, except weeks of tournaments or league games

SUMMER: 2 times per week

TOURNAMENT SCHEDULE

The team will plan for 1-2 fall tournaments, one winter indoor tournament, and 4-5 summer tournaments. These tournaments will include at least one overnight tournament.

INDOOR SCHEDULE

The team will play two mandatory indoor sessions. The team will plan to play at a competitive level.

PLAYING TIME

All players will play in every game. Playing time will be based on demonstrated skills and attitude both in practice and prior games. Playing time will most likely NOT be equal, as it is expected that some players will demonstrate better skills and attitude. Missing practices will impact playing time. Missing games (league, indoor, and tournament) will impact playing time.

TEAM RULES

1. Missing any game or practice without prior notice to the Team Manager will result in a one game suspension from play for the next scheduled game. The suspended player will be expected to attend the game in uniform, but will not play unless in an emergency.
2. Any player MUST notify the Team Manager at least one week prior to any game the player will miss due to school or church functions, or family vacations.
3. Any player can approach and discuss any issue with the Coach at any time.
4. Any player can request a formal meeting with the Coach which can include his parents.
5. Any parent issues or questions MUST be brought to the Team Manager.
6. Poor sportsmanship during practice or games will NOT be tolerated.

INITIAL TEAM PLAYER MEETING

Once the team is formed, there will be a team dinner for the coaches and players ONLY. During this meeting the team and players will discuss expectations of each other for the coming season.

INITIAL TEAM PARENT MEETING

Once the team is established, a meeting will be held with the coaches and the parents ONLY. During this meeting the coaches will discuss their expectations for the players for the coming season, and answer any questions, and determine schedules. Future parent meetings will be scheduled by the Team Manager as required.

FEES

It is estimated the costs per player, including indoor sessions, tournaments, gym space rentals, plus the \$100 player registration fee (to PVYSC) will be \$300-400.
