TEAM MISSION

To foster a winning soccer team by developing individual skills and applying them to the team effort, learning principles of maneuver, instilling respect for the Laws of the Game, displaying good sportsmanship at all times, and enjoying the game (!).

EXPECTATIONS

Tournaments: 1 or 2 in the fall; 2 to 4 in the summer.

Fall Practices: Once per week September into October as weather permits.

Summer Practices: Once per week starting in May as weather permits, for those not on a high school team. Twice per week starting when high school soccer ends.

Indoor: To Be Determined.

Cost: Approximately \$300 per player, depending on final number of tournaments and uniform fee, includes club registration fee. Does not include travel expenses for overnight tournaments.

Players: Players are expected to attend all practices and games. Of course, conflicts will arise for church, family, and other activities, and are quite understandable. However, we ask that these be kept as minimal as possible, especially during the June and July outdoor season, for the benefit of the team. We will try to get all schedules out as soon as available to help in planning. If possible, plan vacation for after the last game in July.

Playing Time: In general, starters will get more playing time than non-starters. Starters are chosen based on many factors, including skills, effort, spirit, attendance at practice, and proficiency at a given position or positions. Being a starter is always open to all players throughout the season on a competitive basis. Other factors that can effect playing time include (but are not limited to) personal conditioning and endurance, ability to play more than one position, the number of players present at a given game, and the competitive situation of a given game. Regardless, all players will play in every game they attend, in both halves.

Team Offers: Offers will be made as soon as the Red Wave completes its roster.

Team Meeting: The first team meeting will be near the end of August at the Neenah Library.
